Onsite? Online? Which one?

Both! This year, VBS is both online and onsite. To understand what we mean, here's our schedule:

1. Sunday, June 21 – Online or Onsite (6:00 – 7:30 p.m. – South Parking Lot near Entry #3)
2. Monday, June 22 - Online
3. Wednesday, June 24 Online or Onsite (6:00 – 7:30 p.m. – South Parking Lot near Entry #3)
4. Friday, June 26 - Online
5. Sunday, June 28 – Online or Onsite (6:00 – 7:30 p.m. – South Parking Lot near Entry #3)

For those wishing to participate online-only, recordings of all of our content will be available online.

How long will the online content be available?

If you fall behind or miss a day, don't worry! We'll keep all of our VBS content up on our VBS page (clcs.org/vbs) throughout the summer. You can catch up any time.

What are you doing to keep my child safe at VBS?

Many of our onsite activities will take place outside, weather permitting.

Whether inside or outside, we encourage families to practice social distancing. Families will sit together for all of our onsite activities, because this year's VBS is family-focused. To make distancing as simple as possible, distancing locations have been marked in our chairs and pews.

We ask all families to wear masks whenever inside. We will have extra masks available when you arrive.

Family-focused VBS?

We want you to grow in faith as a family, so we've designed many of our activities to be done together with your children. Through skits, games, and crafts, you and your children will have many opportunities to both learn and discuss how *"Jesus power pulls us through!"*

Many of our outside opportunities will take place in the grass area between our church and school near Entry #3. You are welcome to bring along your own blankets or chairs for your family to enjoy, but we will also make our folding chairs available for your use.
