1) We are created with a <u>hunger</u> that no physical food can <u>satisfy</u>, a <u>craving</u> that no earthly experience can <u>appease</u>, an <u>itch</u> that no material object can <u>scratch</u>.

⁵¹ I am the living bread that came down from heaven. If anyone eats of this bread, he will live forever. And the bread that I will give for the life of the world is my flesh." … ⁵⁸ This is the bread that came down from heaven, not like the bread the fathers ate, and died. Whoever feeds on this bread will live forever."
