After the completion of their training, the students start making money with their



tailoring skills. Some of the previous graduates are working at home and earning money, while some are working as tailors in various businesses. Tailoring is a great blessing for all who complete their training at CIM. Praise the Lord!



We are happy to see some of our former tailoring students on graduation day. We are looking forward to starting the 8th batch of tailoring students in January 2023. May the Lord bless all the new candidates who are going to be in the next class.

DEDICATING A THIRD TUITION CENTER

What a blessing to report that Calvary India Mission is being expanded by the grace of the Lord. We have started a third Tuition Center in a village called Vadapudhupattu. Pr. Alexander offered prayers and inaugurated the new center on 20th October 2022. There are 27 students (Christian, Hindu and Muslim) in the new tuition center. Class starts after the normal school day and dinner is provided everyday.



We reach out to people with God's love and mercy through the tuition centers. We distributed Bibles to the students and Tamil hymnals to the congregation.
