

Mani (216-276 CE)

• Born in Babylon to a zealous religious family and a zealous religious community, the "Elchaisites".

• Had a vision at 25. An angel told him that he is Jesus' promised "Paraclete." This angel was Mani's glorified self, back from the future.

• The angel told Mani that the true Christian religion had been corrupted, and it was Mani's responsibility to restore it.

Did God really say?

A key aspect of heresy:

Mani (216-276 CE)

• Mani rejects the OT entirely and much the NT.

• He declares all foods clean and is subsequently cast out of his religious community.

• Mani encounters Zoroastrianism and Buddhism, then adds elements of both to Christianity.

· He converts many, even the Persian emperor, Shapur.

Manichaeanism's Fundamentals

• Eternal, cosmic warfare between good and evil explains all that's good and bad with the universe.

• The evil forces imprisoned Primal Man, a fragment of God, in the material world.

• Redemption is God's extraction of Primal Man from the material world through teaching, which awakens the divine spirit in man.

· Humans are both saved by God and God's savior.
