Which one of these comes easiest to you? Why?

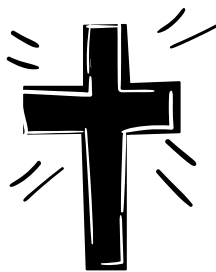
Which one of these do you struggle with the most? Why is that?
