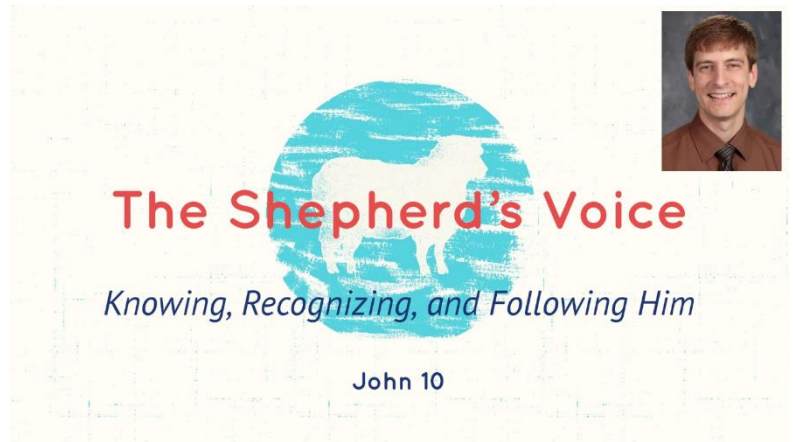


“The Shepherd’s Voice”

- 1) If we're passionate about the truthfulness of the news and its impact on the people of our world, shouldn't we be similarly passionate about the message of the church?
- 2) If I'm going to sort the good news from the bad news, I need to hear and be able to recognize his voice.
- 3) Take time to listen to Him. Spend time with Him. Read Scripture. Pray. Worship. Our first goal is to know Him.
- 4) Knowing Jesus is both a deeper kind of knowing and a more flawed kind of knowing than knowing $1+1=2$.
- 5) Every good gift and every perfect gift is from above, coming down from the Father of lights, with whom there is no variation or shadow due to change. (*James 1:17*)
- 6) And there's no end to knowing Jesus, no "graduation" in knowing Jesus.
- 7) Knowing Jesus is like knowing any other person.
- 8) You make known to me the path of life; in your presence there is fullness of joy; (*Psalms 16:11*)
- 9) It is his unfailing, unflagging love which both saves us and day after day builds us up to be the people he has called us to be.
