To know where we are, it is vital to determine...

1) Where we started

The beginning of the gospel of Jesus Christ, the Son of God.

(Mark 1:1)

2) Where we are going

And they went out and fled from the tomb, for trembling and astonishment had seized them, and they said nothing to anyone, for they were afraid.

(Mark 16:8)

3) And who meets us on the way.

“Behold, I send my messenger before your face, who will prepare your way...”

(Mark 1:2b)

the voice of one crying in the wilderness: "Prepare the way of the Lord, make
his paths straight" *(Mark 1:2–3)*
