1. We live in *anticipation*, *yearning* for all that is to come.

For in this tent we groan, longing to put on our heavenly dwelling ... For while we are still in this tent, we groan, being burdened—not that we would be unclothed, but that we would be further clothed. (2 Corinthians 5:2-4a)

2. We live in *assurance*, *knowing* all that has been accomplished.

He who has prepared us for this very thing is God, who has given us the Spirit as a guarantee. (2 Corinthians 5:5)

3. We live in **hope**, trusting all that has been promised.

So we are always of good courage. We know that while we are at home in the body we are away from the Lord, for we walk by faith, not by sight. Yes, we are of good courage. (2 Corinthians 5:6-8a)
