1) It isn't just for special occasions.

⁴Love is patient and kind; love does not envy or boast; it is not arrogant ⁵ or rude. It does not insist on its own way; it is not irritable or resentful; ⁶ it does not rejoice at wrongdoing, but rejoices with the truth. (1 Corinthians 13:4–6)

2) <u>Time</u> -- The true <u>test</u> of love.

⁷Love bears all things, believes all things, hopes all things, endures all things. ⁸Love never ends... (*1 Corinthians 13:7–8a*)
