## The confidence that comes in knowing Christ Jesus changes our...

1) Past — Because of Christ's death, I live by His righteousness not my own.

7 But whatever gain I had, I counted as loss for the sake of Christ. 8 Indeed, I count everything as loss because of the surpassing worth of knowing Christ Jesus my Lord.

(Philippians 3:7–8a)

2) Present — Because of Christ's <u>resurrection</u>, I am empowered for <u>life</u> and <u>service</u> even in difficult circumstances.

...in order that I may gain Christ 9 and be found in him, not having a righteousness of my own that comes from the law, but that which comes through faith in Christ, the righteousness from God that depends on faith— 10 that I may know him and the power of his resurrection, and may share his sufferings, becoming like him in his death.

Philippians 3:8c-10)

3) Future — Because of Christ's <u>return</u>, I can live in <u>hope</u> and <u>expectation</u>.

But one thing I do: forgetting what lies behind and straining forward to what lies ahead, 14 I press on toward the goal for the prize of the upward call of God in Christ Jesus.
