**Have you ever found yourself in a situation where you were totally overqualified and underestimated? How did you respond?**

- 1) Were Jesus recognized as he deserves, all of creation would have travelled to see him.

<sup>6</sup> Oh come, let us worship and bow down; let us kneel before the Lord, our Maker!

<sup>7</sup> For he is our God, and we are the people of his pasture, and the sheep of his hand.

Today, if you hear his voice, <sup>8</sup> do not harden your hearts, as at Meribah, as on the day at Massah in the wilderness...

*(Psalm 95:6-8)*

- 2) Even when unappreciated, unwelcome, or ignored, Jesus still came to save.

<sup>5</sup> Have this mind among yourselves, which is yours in Christ Jesus, <sup>6</sup> who, though he was in the form of God, did not count equality with God a thing to be grasped, <sup>7</sup> but emptied himself, by taking the form of a servant, being born in the likeness of men. <sup>8</sup> And being found in human form, he humbled himself by becoming obedient to the point of death, even death on a cross.
