1) We are not alone on life’s journey. We are accompanied by a community — Father, Son and Holy Spirit.

²⁹“And he who sent me is with me. He has not left me alone, for I always do the things that are pleasing to him.” . . . ³¹ So Jesus said to the Jews who had believed him, “If you abide in my word, you are truly my disciples, ³²and you will know the truth, and the truth will set you free”
(*John 8:29, 31–32*)

2) We are each bearers of the Image of God.

⁵³“Are you greater than our father Abraham, who died? And the prophets died! Who do you make yourself out to be?” ⁵⁴ Jesus answered, “If I glorify myself, my glory is nothing. It is my Father who glorifies me...”
(*John 8:53–54a*)

3) The Church is a sign of the Trinity’s unity-in-diversity.

⁹ After this I looked, and behold, a great multitude that no one could number, from every nation, from all tribes and peoples and languages, standing before the throne and before the Lamb, clothed in white robes, with palm branches in their hands, ¹⁰and crying out with a loud voice, “Salvation belongs to our God who sits on the throne, and to the Lamb!”
