1) The Good Samaritan is not primarily about how we treat our neighbor.

2) The Good Samaritan is about God's love for us.

A lawyer stood up to put him to the test, saying, “Teacher, what shall I do to inherit eternal life?”
(Luke 10:25)

3) Jesus challenges us to love everyone like we love ourselves.
