1) Two Kinds of <u>People</u>: <u>Repentant</u> and <u>Unrepentant</u>.

Be diligent to present yourself approved to God, a worker who does not need to be ashamed, rightly dividing the word of truth. (2 Timothy 2:15)

For the word of God is living and active, sharper than any two-edged sword, piercing to the division of soul and of spirit...and discerning the thoughts and intentions of the heart.

(Hebrews 4:12)

2) Two Kinds of <u>Righteousness</u>: <u>Passive</u> and <u>Active</u>.

For though I am free from all, I have made myself a servant to all, that I might win more of them.

(1 Corinthians 9:19)

For freedom Christ has set us free . . . do not submit again to a yoke of slavery . . . For you were called to freedom. Only do not use your freedom as an opportunity for the flesh, but through love serve one another. (*Galatians 5:1, 13*)

3) Two Kinds of Movements: Inward for Worship and Outward for Mission.

Come to me, all who labor and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest... (Matthew 11:28)

I have become all things to all people, that by all means I might save some. I do it all for the sake of the gospel, that I may share with them in its blessings...

(1 Corinthians 9:22–23)

For what is our hope or joy or crown of boasting before our Lord Jesus at his coming? Is it not you? For you are our glory and joy...

(1 Thessalonians 2:19-20)
