1. Not simply an adorable act, but the miraculous action that changes our past, present, and future.

³Do you not know that all of us who have been baptized into Christ Jesus were baptized into his death? ⁴We were buried therefore with him by baptism into death, in order that, just as Christ was raised from the dead by the glory of the Father, we too might walk in newness of life. ⁵For if we have been united with him in a death like his, we shall certainly be united with him in a resurrection like his. *(Romans 6:3–5)*

2. What will you do with this gift of life?

⁸Now if we have died with Christ, we believe that we will also live with him. ⁹We know that Christ, being raised from the dead, will never die again; death no longer has dominion over him . . . ¹¹So you also must consider yourselves dead to sin and alive to God in Christ Jesus. *(Romans 6:8–9, 11)*
