## 1. The hidden God is awesome, incomprehensible, unlimited in power.

Truly, you are a God who hides himself, O God of Israel, the Savior. *(Isaiah 47:15)*

Great is the Lord, and greatly to be praised, and his greatness is unsearchable. *(Psalm 145:3)*

## 2. God's presence and power are terrifying.

Therefore I am terrified at his presence; when I consider, I am in dread of him. 16 God has made my heart faint; the Almighty has terrified me. *Job 23:15)*

And I said: "Woe is me! For I am lost; for I am a man of unclean lips, and I dwell in the midst of a people of unclean lips; for my eyes have seen the King, the LORD of hosts!" *(Isaiah 6:5)*

He got up, rebuked the wind and said to the waves, "Quiet! Be still!" Then the wind died down and it was completely calm. He said to his disciples, "Why are you so afraid? Do you still have no faith?" They were terrified and asked each other, "Who is this? Even the wind and the waves obey him!" *(Mark 4:39–41)*

## 3. What does Jesus reveal? Peace.

"Rise, and have no fear." *(Matthew 17:7)*

"Daughter, your faith has made you well; go in peace." *Luke 8:48)*

"Peace be with you." *(John 20:26b)*
